Instructions (Applicants/Senior Naval Science Instructors)

- 1. Visit our website: http://www.subr.edu/subhome/14/
- 2. Click the "Scholarship Information" tab on the left-hand side.
- 3. Applicants: Download the Presidential NROTC Preparatory Scholarship application form, save the form locally to your computer.
- 4. Senior Naval Science Instructors (As Applicable): Download the Senior Naval Science Instructor recommendation form, save the form locally to your computer.
- 5. Open the forms in Adobe Reader. Adobe Reader is available free from this website: https://get.adobe.com/reader/
- 6. Fill out the forms to completion. Note: Write your essay in Microsoft Word first so that you can utilize spell-check. Cut and paste your completed essays into the application form. Max allowed essay length is approximately one page, single-spaced in Microsoft Word. Ensure your entire essay is visible in the form when printed.
- 7. When complete, print and sign form using pen.
- 8. Applicants: Scan the signed document and forward it along with your photograph (as applicable), transcripts, SAT/ACT scores, AFA scores, and any documents you feel will be necessary to the application to LT Gurzynski at william gurzynski@subr.edu.
- 9. Senior Naval Science Instructors: Scan and send the signed document to LT Gurzynski.
- 10. Notify LT Gurzynski once the online application to Southern University has been completed.
